## Introduction of Miri City



Pada 9 Januari 1961, Majlis Bandaran telah diubah kepada Majlis Daerah Miri


Pada 6 November 1981 status Majlis daerah telah dinaikkan kepada Majlis Perbandaran Miri

## Initiatives of LCCF

- Miri has been selected as one of five pilot locations in Malaysia to be a Green Resort City to be based on the Low Carbon Cities Framework (LCCF) developed by Ministry of Energy, Green Technology and Water in collaboration with Malaysian Green Technology Corporation.
